frequently asked questions

Is there an application fee?

There is no charge to apply for Project Blueprint.

What is the cost of program?

The cost of the program is \$675.

What does the program fee cover?

The program fee covers all participation-related expenses.

When is the fee due?

Once candidates have been accepted as members of Class XLII, the fee is due by February 8, 2023

When will the application become available?

The application is available now and can be accessed at unitedwayhouston.org/nonprofit-connection/projectblueprint/apply

When is the application deadline?

The application deadline has been extended to December 15, 2022.

When will I be notified if I am accepted into the program?

Notification of candidates will occur by February 1, 2023.

How long is the program?

The program will begin on February 17, 2023 and end on April 26, 2023.

When and where are classes held?

Classes and other program activities will be both in-person and virtual (COVID restrictions permitting). A retreat will be held at an off-site Houston location; and in-person activities will be held at United Way's main campus at 50 Waugh Dr. Houston.

What topics are covered during the program?

The curriculum includes governance, fiscal management, resource development and all other aspects of board service.

Am I allowed to miss classes once the program begins?

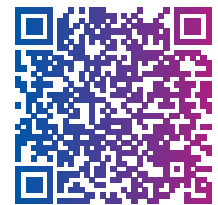
Candidates are expected to attend all classes once the program is under way; one excused absence is permitted in the event of an unexpected business or personal situation.

How large is a typical class?

Hybrid class size will be up to 25 participants.
