13% of households across Greater Houston live on incomes below the federal poverty line, and 31% are working hard but unable to afford life's basic necessities.

For them, the path to financial stability is often unclear and too long for any one resource to cover fully.

how your gifts make a difference

\$5

a week can provide six weeks of academically enriching out-of-school programming for a young person.

\$10

a week can provide 20 workforce development sessions to help clients increase their income and better support their families.

\$20

a week can provide a month of meals for a family of three struggling to choose between buying food and medicine or paying rent.

\$50

a week can provide seven months of quality early childhood education for children from lower-income families, helping ensure they reach key milestones and are ready to succeed when they enter Kindergarten.

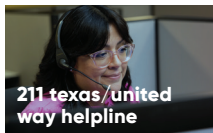
91,083 neighbors received support to achieve financial stability.

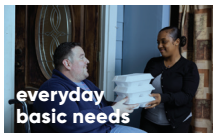
1.2 million neighbors were connected with help and hope.

The 211 Texas/United Way HELPLINE connects people to vital services 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year. Whether someone needs help with food, housing, health care, child care, or disaster recovery, 211 is there.



252,029 people received health care support.

Physical and behavioral health care programs, like primary care, dental care, individual and family counseling, and substance use recovery, help people remain resilient and connected in their financial stability journey.



219,372 neighbors got help with their basic necessities.

Your support strengthens community safety nets, including stabilizing services like food, housing, and transportation. Meeting these basic needs helps those in crisis find the stability needed to focus on their futures.



38,116 people got support to escape violent environments

United Way and our partners provide support to those living in violent, aggressive, or otherwise unsafe environments (domestic abuse, human trafficking, etc.) who need assistance to escape and be safe.

integrated services, lasting results

financial stability

Programs including vocational training, employment coaching, tax preparation services, financial coaching, and accessible financial products help people achieve a sustainable quality of life.

early childhood

Long-term success—for kids and their parents—starts with early childhood and youth development programs. Early childhood education, quality child care, out-of-school programs and more help children reach academic milestones and help parents focus on their financial stability journeys.

health care

Keeping people healthy and able to pursue their goals is a community effort. We support programs including specialty and behavioral health care services.

basic needs

United Way supports our neighbors with basic needs, such as housing assistance, utility assistance, technology access, shelter, transportation, food, escape from violence, and more.

legal services

Our work supports general legal services and advocacy to help our neighbors navigate challenges such as eviction, expungement, family law issues, immigration rights, and more.

integrated client journey

Our Integrated Client Journey convenes 100+ partners to create opportunities based on each client's unique goals and needs. Instead of navigating multiple programs repeatedly, clients get a Navigator—a personal guide helping them create a custom plan integrating services and resources from multiple partners to address their wide-ranging needs holistically.
