### When your basic needs aren't met, it is difficult to think about the future.

Achieving financial stability requires that you and your family's basic needs are met so that you can plan and save for your goals or unexpected expenses. But for too many in Greater Houston, impossible choices, like deciding between food, rent, or medicine are a daily concern.

#### Connecting our neighbors to help and hope

13% of households across Greater Houston are living on incomes below the federal poverty threshold, and another 31% of households are working hard but can't afford the basic necessities of life. This is underscored by calls to our 211 Texas/ United Way HELPLINE, many of which are for help with basic needs.
